- REQUIREMENTS:** To successfully complete the BSN major, the following coursework is required:
- 36 credits Nursing Mobility Profile II, Direct Articulation Agreement, or PA Articulation Agreement
 - 24 Prerequisite credits which must include 12 science credits
 - 30 Liberal Arts credits
 - 18 Nursing Component credits
 - 12 credits of Nursing Electives
 - A minimum number of 120 credits is required for degree, the last 30 of which must be earned at La Roche College. (Developmental course work does not count toward the minimum number of required credits for graduation.)
