PURPOSE: A major in Elementary Education is meant to prepare students for a career as an elementary education teacher. A student will seek PA Department of Education Certification. Students must meet all of the competency standards set by the PA Department of Education, and they must pass the related PRAXIS tests. Students must also maintain the following QPA requirements of 3.0 QPA for entrance and exit.

REQUIREMENTS: To successfully complete the Elementary Education major, the following coursework is required:

- 24 credits as listed under "Major Component/Requirements"
- 56 credits of Education Component
- 40 CORE credits
- A minimum number of 120 credits is required for degree, the last 30 of which must be earned at La Roche College. (Developmental course work does not count toward the minimum number of required credits for graduation.)

DISCLAIMER: The State of Pennsylvania is in the process of changing its education certification programs. Students planning to graduate by August 2013 should follow this program guide for Elementary Education (K-6). Students with graduation dates after August 2013 should speak with a LRC Education advisor.
