**PURPOSE:** Minors are offered as opportunities for students to fulfill career or personal interests, and/or to facilitate in depth study in a field of secondary interest.

**GENERAL RESTRICTIONS:** Minors must be completed within the student's graduation timeline. Students may not major and minor in the same department (Example: human services majors may not declare a psychology minor). At least one of the psychology electives must be an upper division course (300 or 400 level).

**AVAILABILITY:** Required coursework available during the day and evening; two academic years estimated for minor completion (Course rotation and prerequisites). Evening rotation may take longer. (NOTE: Estimate assumes student completion of zero minor credits at time of minor declaration.)
