Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is a 4-part proctored assessment test that consists of subtests in reading, math, science, and English. These testing scores are required for all applicants to the Associate of Nursing program at La Roche College.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Why do I need to take the TEAS test? La Roche College School of Nursing requires the TEAS exam scores as part of the admission requirements for the Associate of Science in Nursing.

What's on the TEAS exam and how long will it take me to complete?

TEAS is a timed 4-part assessment that includes:

- 40 reading questions – 50 minutes
- 45 mathematics questions – 56 minutes
- 30 science questions – 38 minutes
- 55 English/Language usage questions – 65 minutes

Plan on being here for 4 hours.

May I use a calculator for the Mathematics questions?

No, use of a calculator is not permitted. The mathematics questions are basic and you may use a paper and pencil to do your calculations.

How many times can I take the TEAS test? La Roche College only permits one attempt at the TEAS test. Failure to pass results in not being considered for our Associate of Science in Nursing program; study materials and sample tests can be found at www.atitesting.com.

What is the TEAS exam score admission requirements for La Roche College?

Your adjusted individual total score must be at least 58.7%

What if I have taken the TEAS previously?

If you have already taken the TEAS elsewhere, then you must bring an official copy of your exam score here for admission consideration. You are not permitted to take the TEAS a second time.

I have not taken Algebra, Biology or Chemistry since high school. How can I prepare for successful completion of the TEAS?

You can take the practice exams through ATI as described above. Additionally, it would be advisable for you to take Algebra, Biology and Chemistry courses through www.nursingabc.com.
