INTRODUCTION

The La Roche University Class of 2020 consists of students who graduated in August 2019, September 2019 (Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice students), December 2019 and May 2020.

The Outcomes Survey was initiated by the Office of Career Development prior to graduation and concluded approximately six months after each graduation date.

Additional data was gathered from online sources, employers and faculty. This method of reporting career outcomes data follows the reporting guidelines established by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE).

La Roche made a good faith effort to verify the information obtained by all sources other than the responding graduates.

OUTCOMES TERMINOLOGY

Cohort Size: Number of students.

Career Outcomes: The percentage of graduates who are employed full- or part-time, in military or volunteer service, and/or enrolled in continuing education.

Knowledge Rate: The percentage of graduates for which the institution has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities.

DATA COLLECTION METHODS

Data was collected for all graduates who obtained a degree from La Roche University during the designated academic year. The following steps were followed during the data collection period:

- 1 Shortly before graduation, potential graduates were identified by the La Roche University Registrar and Office of Career Development. These students were sent emails inviting them to complete the Outcomes Survey.
- 2 The list of survey respondents was continuously updated for accuracy after graduation based on a student's degree status.
- 3 Over a six-month period, automated reminder emails were sent out from the Outcomes Survey platform to graduates who had yet to respond.
- 4 Data provided by the August 2019, September 2019, December 2019 and May 2020 cohorts were combined to produce the annual report that was then shared with the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE).
- 5 Outcomes data was presented by degree for the entire graduating class year and also by degree type.
