Scholar Credit Initiative Program (SCIP)

Are you ready to take on-campus or online college classes and receive college credits while you're still in high school? Then you need to apply for the Scholar Credit Initiative Program (SCIP) through La Roche University.

SCIP is a dual-enrollment program which allows you to earn up to 15 credits toward your college education at La Roche or many other accredited institutions across the country – all while you are still in high school. That means you'll be ahead when you get to college!



Program Benefits

- Save money while earning college credits. You pay \$235 per credit hour vs. \$811 per credit hour.
- You'll get used to the college learning environment sooner.
- Choose from a wide variety of courses such as history, English, math and more.

Requirements

To be considered for SCIP at La Roche University, you must:

- Be a high school sophomore, junior or senior.
- Submit a completed SCIP application form to the Office of Freshman Admissions.
- Submit a current transcript demonstrating a GPA of 3.0 or greater and at least sophomore standing at the time of application.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from your high school counselor. *Home-schooled students may submit a letter of recommendation from an organization leader or advisor.*

** Once enrolled in SCIP, you must maintain a 3.0 high school GPA and La Roche GPA of 2.0.*



Other College-in-High-School Programs

Scholar is another dual-enrollment program at La Roche. Unlike SCIP, Scholar is offered in a number of Pennsylvania high schools, with high school faculty teaching courses for university credit.
