La Roche University Core Curriculum Requirements

History **3 credits required**
Any History course at BC3 will fulfill the course requirement.

Philosophy/Religion **3 credits required**
Any Religion or Philosophy course at BC3 will fulfill the course requirement.

English **6 credits required**
BC3 ENGL101 and 102 will fulfill the course requirements.

Literature **3 credits required**
Any Literature course at BC3 will fulfill the course requirement unless specified by a specific major such as English, English Education and Elementary Education.

Aesthetics **3 credits required**
Any Art, Music or Theater course at BC3 will fulfill the course requirement.

Math **3 credits required**
MATH100 (College Algebra), MATH101 (Intermediate Algebra) or any higher-level Math class at BC3 will fulfill the course requirement.

Science **3 credits required**
Any Science course at BC3, including Computer Science, will fulfill the course requirement unless specified by a specific major in one of the Sciences.

Social Sciences **3 credits required**
Courses offered in Sociology and Anthropology may fulfill the social science requirement.

Any course eligible for transfer credit to La Roche University from these departments will fulfill the requirements. Please see individual department listings.

Computer Applications **3 credits required**
COMP210 (Intro to Microcomputing) at BC3 will fulfill the course requirement.
