## La Roche University Core Curriculum Requirements

#### History 3 credits required

Any History course at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement.

#### Philosophy/Religion 3 credits required

Any Religion or Philosophy course at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement.

#### English 6 credits required

CCBC WRIT101 and 102 will fulfill the course requirements. (WRIT300 will fulfill ENG1011 requirements.)

#### Literature 3 credits required

Any Literature course at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement unless specified by a specific major such as English, English Education and Elementary Education.

#### Aesthetics 3 credits required

Any Art, Music or Theater course at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement.

#### Math 3 credits required

MATH130 (College Algebra), or any higher-level Math class at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement. (MATH300 will fulfill MATH1010 requirements.)

#### Science 3 credits required

Any Science course, including Computer Science, at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement unless specified by a specific major in one of the Sciences.

#### Social Sciences 3 credits required

Courses offered in Sociology and Anthropology may fulfill the social science requirement.

Any course eligible for transfer credit to LRU from these departments will fulfill the requirements. Please see individual department listings.

### Computer Applications 3 credits required

CIST100 (Microcomputer Applications) at CCBC will fulfill the course requirement.
