La Roche College Core Curriculum Requirements

History 3 credits required

Any History course at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement.

Philosophy/Religion 3 credits required

Any Religion or Philosophy course at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement.

English 6 credits required

CCAC ENG101 and ENG102 will fulfill the course requirements.

Literature 3 credits required

Any Literature course at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement unless specified by a specific major such as English, English Education and Elementary Education.

Aesthetics 3 credits required

Any Art, Music or Theatre course at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement.

Math 3 credits required

MAT108, MAT110 or any higher-level Math class at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement.

Science 3 credits required

Any Science course, including Computer Science, at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement unless specified by a specific major in one of the Sciences.

Social Sciences 3 credits required

Courses offered in Sociology and Anthropology may fulfill the social science requirement.

Any course eligible for transfer credit to LRC from these departments will fulfill the requirements. Please see individual department listings.

Computer Applications 3 credits required

CIT100 (Intro to Computers) or CIT140 (Office Productivity Applications) at CCAC will fulfill the course requirement.
