

## University Update Regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

**To: La Roche University Community**

**Date: March 23, 2020**

In compliance with Governor Tom Wolf's recent directive to close all non-life-sustaining businesses and enforce a stay-at-home ordinance, the University has made the following changes:

- Only essential campus personnel are to report to campus. All other employees are to work remotely as directed by their supervisor until further notice. All offices remain open on a virtual basis.
- Wright Library is closed until further notice. Computer labs are available to on-campus students only.
  - HAC208 – Daily from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.
  - MACLAB – 24-hour card access for design and film majors only
  - CADLAB – 24-hour card access for design and film majors only

Computer stations will be disinfected regularly and sanitary wipes will be available in the labs.

- The move out process for resident students will be suspended after 8 p.m. on Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Those who cannot move out by this time will not be able to return to campus for their belongings until further notice.
